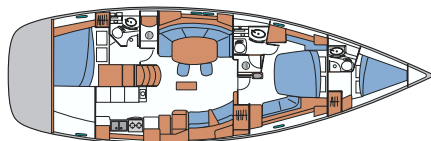
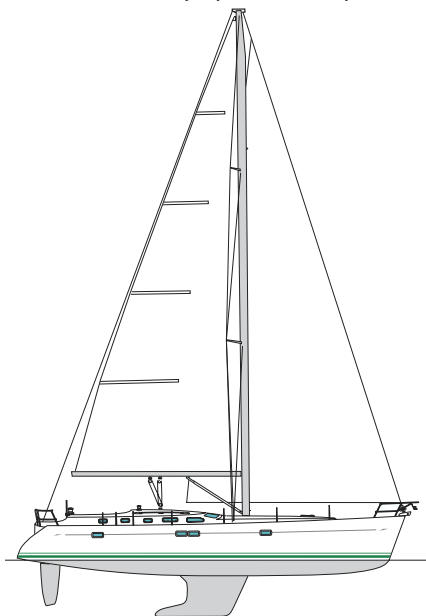
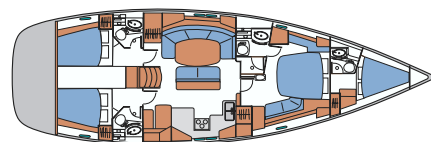

### STEERING SYSTEM

Rudder with glass composite stock  
Dual helm station in aft cockpit  
Twin 1000mm dia. leather trimmed steering wheels  
Twin bulkhead type steering gear  
(2) steering compasses w/stainless steel handrail  
Emergency tiller  
Bow thruster w/separate 12V battery

### ON DECK

Welded stainless steel bow fitting w/(2) bow rollers  
(6) 400mm alum. mooring cleats & SS rubbing strike plate (bow, midships, stern)  
Self-draining anchor locker w/eye bolt for bitter end  
1800W horizontal electric windlass w/circuit breaker & 12V relay, integral up & down controls  
3/8" gypsy  
Double locker lids for easy access  
Stainless steel open pulpit forward w/teak step and navigation lights (1 port and 1 starboard)  
Stainless steel stern pulpit  
Lifelines supported by (8) single and (4) double stainless steel stanchions  
Teak caprails  
(2) hinged boarding gates for transom access  
(4) stainless steel handrails on coachroof (forward and midships)  
(2) stainless steel mast rails.  
(2) large sail lockers & storage space for lines  
(2) lockers under helm seats  
(1) double gas tank locker to port  
Teak slatted cockpit floor to port  
Teak drop-leaf cockpit table, stainless steel base and GRP support (bottle and glass storage) and stainless steel handrail. The chart plotter fits into the back of support  
(2) glass holders, port & starboard helm positions  
(2) waterproof speakers  
Cockpit light w/12V socket  
Locker for liferaft storage on aft deck  
Wet locker to port on aft deck  
Teak slatted swim platform  
Swim ladder with teak treads  
Cockpit shower w/pressurized hot & cold water  
Protective rubber transom guard

### STANDING RIGGING

Stainless steel standing rigging (forestay, upper shrouds, aft lower shrouds, double backstay)  
Genoa furling gear  
Optional inner forestay

### RUNNING RIGGING

Main halyard led aft to electric winch  
(2) automatic reefing lines  
Genoa halyard with jammer for mast storage (to free up cockpit space)  
Boom topping lift  
Mainsail sheet with tackle  
(2) genoa sheets  
Rigid boom vang with tackle  
(1) genoa furling line led aft to cockpit  
(2) deck organizers with (6) sheaves  
(7) jammers to port (electric winch) and (3) to starboard are standard  
(6) cleats for halyards and reefing lines

### SAILS

140 % genoa with anti-UV protection strip  
Semi fully battened mainsail  
Optional in-mast lazy Jacks, sand or blue colored  
Lazy Bag

### MAINSAIL SYSTEM

Mainsheet traveller on coachroof w/control lines led aft to cockpit  
Mainsheet block assembly  
Mainsheet led aft onto electric winch in cockpit

### GENOA SYSTEM

Genoa furling line is led aft to electric winch  
(2) 11'6" genoa tracks w/adjustable cars  
Sheets are led aft to winches w/in reach of helm

### WINCHES

(2) genoa sheet winches (66.2 STC)  
(2) coachroof winches (44.2 STC), including (1) electric winch to port  
(3) winch handles and (2) winch handle pockets

### ENGINE

Engine mounting built into the hull liner  
Foam sound-proofed engine compartment  
Engine control panel and control lever at helm  
Stainless steel propeller shaft w/GRP skeg  
Flexi-fold 3-blade propeller  
119 gal fuel tank (optional extra 53 gal capacity)

### ELECTRICAL

12V, 24-function electrical panel & 4-function 110V panel  
12V sockets  
4 x 140 Amp service batteries  
1 x 140 Amp engine battery  
Voltmeter and ammeter  
Battery charge warning light  
Monitor for water and fuel tanks  
110V shore supply with 40 Amp battery charger  
Alternator with power distributor

For the Salon-to-port Version:

(8) sockets  
(36) halogen ceiling lights  
(7) reading lights  
(2) fluorescent lights  
(3) lamps with shades  
(4) courtesy lights (in plinths)  
(2) indirect lights in salon  
Navigation lights (stern & bow), combined steaming and deck light, and anchor light

### WATER SYSTEM

Draining: Water system w/filters & expansion tank  
All sea-cocks are fitted with turn-off valves  
Electric shower pump in the head compartments  
Manual and electric bilge pump  
Fresh water : 250 gal standard

Hot Water: provided by a 11 gal water heater or by a 110V shore power supply  
Cold water shower on swim platform  
Hot and cold shower on transom

### INTERIOR LAYOUT/OWNER'S CABIN FORWARD

Island Berth type double berth w/slatted base (6'6" x 4'7") with high density foam mattress  
Shelving along the hull  
Two drawers under the berth  
Hanging locker to port & starboard  
Closed shelving w/vented doors  
Bench seat to port  
Dresser table w/courtesy mirror & bench seat  
(2) reading lamps with shades on bulkhead  
(3) halogen ceiling lights with two-way switch and (2) lightbars  
(5) opening hatches

### PRIVATE HEAD COMPARTMENT FORWARD WITH SEPARATE SHOWER CABIN

Separate shower  
Acrylic large bowl marine toilet  
Molded washbasin and glass counter  
Hot and cold mixer tap (washbasin)  
Hot and cold mixer tap w/flexible hose & shower head (shower)  
Mirrors  
Cupboard  
(2) halogen ceiling lights and lightbar  
Opening hatch

### SALON TO PORT 3 Cabin, 3 Head version

U-shaped salon with settee and (4) cushions  
Modular salon table on stainless steel base  
Bar unit and cupboard closed by fitted door with ventilation slots  
White hull liner to sides  
(2) opening ports and (1) fixed port w/curtains  
Hull ports with curtains  
(1) opening deck hatch

Large panoramic window 3 x (320 x 600) with OCEANAIR pleated blinds  
(2) opening hatches with blinds  
(5) halogen ceiling lights  
Ceiling with lined wood finish

### CHART TABLE TO STARBOARD

Chart table w/chart storage & molded wood Panel for navigation instruments  
Curved navigator's seat with storage  
Shelf under chart table  
Opening hatch w/curtain over chart table  
Stereo radio/CD player with (2) speakers in salon and (2) speakers in the cockpit  
Electrical panel  
(2) halogen ceiling lights

### GALLEY TO STARBOARD

Gimballed stainless steel 3-burner Force 10 w/oven and stainless steel stove protection bar  
(1) 12V, 34 gal front opening electric fridge  
Microwave built into work surface unit  
Synthetic resin counter top  
Rectangular double stainless steel sink  
Mixer tap with hot and cold water  
(2) opening ports with curtains  
Opening hatch with blind  
(3) halogen and (1) fluorescent ceiling lights

### TWO AFT HEAD COMPARTMENTS

Shower  
Acrylic large bowl marine toilet  
Holding tank in all heads  
Moulded washbasin with glass countertop  
Hot and cold mixer tap  
Mirrors  
Locker in starboard heads for holding tank  
Opening port  
Halogen ceiling light and lightbar

### COMPANIONWAY

Molded wooden steps & solid wooden sides  
Hinged with gas struts for easy engine access  
1.6" sound-proofing foam  
Sliding companionway hatch & removable varnished wood door w/permanent ventilation  
Tinted plexiglass hatch boards

### TWO AFT CABINS (port & starboard)

Double berth 6'7" x 5'8"  
Shelving along the hull, storage under cockpit  
Hanging locker  
(2) opening ports to cockpit with curtains  
(2) opening ports w/curtains on coachroof  
(2) opening hatches with blinds  
(1) ceiling light and (2) reading lights

### CREW CABIN (option)

Access to bow cabin thru opening deck hatch with stainless steel ladder on bulkhead  
Double berth 6'7" x 5'3"  
Shelving along both sides of hull  
Hanging locker  
White vinyl hull liner  
(3) ceiling lights and two reading lights  
Shower  
Large marine toilet bowl w/GRP lid  
Holding tank (option)  
Washbasin & mirror  
Hot and cold mixer shower tap  
Locker  
Lewmar opening hatch  
(2) ceiling lights and lightbar
